Submissions are now open for a Community Conference in organizational neuroscience, co-sponsored by the Academy of Management's Interest Group in Organizational Neuroscience (NEU) and the Rotterdam School of Management at Erasmus University. The conference will take place from June 15-17, 2023 in Rotterdam (Netherlands).

Program at a glance

The conference programme includes a mix of formats. They include plenary and interactive poster sessions, a PDW, a doctoral consortium, keynote speakers, informal networking and social events.

Three plenary sessions will include invited panellists addressing:

- Key research issues in organisational neuroscience
- Editors' perspectives on publishing organisational neuroscience
- External stakeholders' perspectives on the developments, use, and possible pitfalls of organizational neuroscience

The line-up of panellists will include leading international scholars working in organizational neuroscience and neuroscience, key practitioners, members of the EU Commission and policymakers, as well editors from journals such as *Academy of Management Journal*, *Personnel Psychology*, *Journal of Applied Psychology*, and *Journal of Management Studies*, among others. In addition, we will be privileged to host a keynote session by Professor Scott Shane at Weatherhead School of Management.

What is included?

- Access to three days of peer-reviewed scientific content, including workshops, professional panels and dedicated poster sessions
- Access to the abstract book online
- The opportunity to network and liaise with research colleagues and leading academics, editors, and policymakers
- The opportunity to meet colleagues face-to-face again & participate in off-site activities
- Coffee breaks, receptions and lunches each day
- Social dinner on Friday 16 June

Submissions

We welcome submissions for **poster presentations**. Submissions should summarize empirical work or theory development in the area of organizational neuroscience. An anonymized submission should be up to 3 double-spaced pages in a 12-point font Word document (*.doc), inclusive of a required abstract (250-word maximum) on the first page. References, tables, and figures can exceed the 3-page limit. *It is acceptable that work related to the proposal submitted to this conference may have already been submitted to the 2023 AOM Annual Meeting in Boston.*

Submissions close on **April 30, 2023 at 23:59 CET – The notifications of acceptance will**

be provided rapidly after submission and on a rolling basis to facilitate travel planning; reviewers' feedback will be provided after the submission window closes.

Conference Awards will include the best conference poster award (500 Euros sponsored by NEU AOM) and the best PhD student poster award (500 Euros sponsored by Dipartimento di Scienze Aziendali e Giuridiche, Università della Calabria).

The conference will be hosted at the Erasmus University Rotterdam in the Erasmus Pavilion.
